- 1. Welcome: In attendance, we have Amanda Mitchell, Karen Peterson, Janae Howell, Maree Pope, Julie Lundell, and Lori James. Not in attendance: Erica Polley
- 2. Review of Minutes: First meeting of the year
- 3. School Improvement Plan: 94% or better attendance in 34 terms minimum, Dibels growth goal of 63% or better in K-3, and math proficiency of 40% or better in 3-6 summative testing. School Trustlands budget goes to support these goals. We are also using this money to upgrade sound systems, upgrade technology and carts to charge devices.
- 4. School Business: Accreditation team will visit Clinton on Tuesday, October 8th. Mrs. Lundell shared the accreditation video. The team will visit with 7 teachers, some students and administrators, and touring the school. Parent interviews will occur as well in another venue.
- 5. Community Business: A training for Community Council will be on November 7th at Centennial Jr. High. We voted on a chair for the Council and that will be Janae Howell. Minutes will be kept by Lori James, asst principal, as a non-voting member of Community Council.

The suggestion was made to evaluate if our teachers are up to date with professional development, as far as current reading research and training, and for us to determine if TAs are the best use of Trustlands, or if more of the budget might be directed toward teacher training. Mrs. Lundell shared the new phonemic awareness program that is targeting these skills, and encourages us all to keep an open mind in future targets for Trustlands funding. The point was also brought up to perhaps have conversations between our school and Sunset Jr. about holes in math instruction that might be addressed in future funding decisions for Trustlands, as well.
